Once we partnered with family members for the Turchi label, Dave's sisters decided they didn't want to be left out of the action. C3 was designed to be a contemporary label that celebrates the unique backgrounds of the three Corey siblings. The first vintage was 2005 and the focus is on a lesser known varietal, the Tempranillo grape-most notably grown in Spain.

The first culprit is one year younger than Dave, Melanie Corey-Ferrini, a world traveler (her kids are grown!) and architect in Seattle, Washington with her own company called Dynamik Space. Melanie also contributed her original travel sketches from Peru as the focal points for the label design.



The baby of the family, Sherri Corey Pinero is a registered dietitian in Southern California and is raising two young children with her husband John. She also has her own business called Recipe Analysis where she is a food industry consultant, professional speaker and weight management coach.

We produce approximately 600 cases per year and most of it is sold within California. The fruit comes from two locations, both cool climate at Laetitia Vineyard in Arroyo Grande and Santa Barbara Highlands Vineyard in the Cuyama Valley.
